

Electric Vehicle Public Charging Options around Hungerford

HEAT has written this guide to help local EV owners and visitors to the Town find the most suitable public charge points for their needs.

The currently available options are summarised in this table and explanatory notes follow below. Prices are as at **3/5/2025** and are subject to change by suppliers.


EV charge point etiquette

Slow – on-street charge points



These lamppost or bollard mounted kerbside charge points are on the High Street

(x4), Charnham Street (x2), Canal Walk (x1), Park Street (x1) and Priory Road(x1). Whilst these are not heavily used, unfortunately the parking spaces adjacent to them are not reserved for the charge point use and so one might need to search around for one that can be reached. To get a reasonable amount of charge you will need to be parked for several hours or overnight. On the High Street you pay for parking (8am



– 6pm). You will need a Type 2 AC charging lead to connect your vehicle. For the cheapest charging having an Octopus Electroverse account is recommended to get an 8% discount.

Fast – in Church Street and Station Road car parks

Two 22kW (max) charge points are located in the car park adjacent to the Hungerford Hub and Library and nearest to the railway lines in Station Road car park. The charging rate depends on the EV's capability with many only being able to take 6-7kW on an AC charge point. Parking charges apply at all times in the car park. You will need your Type 2 AC charging lead. For the cheapest charging having an Octopus Electroverse account is recommended to get an 8% discount.



Rapids – In Church Street car park and at Cobbs Farm shop



The single Rapid in Church Street car park and the 6 InstaVolt brand ones at Cobbs Farm all have both CCS (Combined Charging System) and CHAdeMo (mainly used by Nissan EVs) connectors on them but only one or the other can be used concurrently. Although they are rated at 50kW and 160kW respectively the actual rate achieved will depend on the vehicle capability and its level of charge at the time. As with all DC (direct



current) Rapid charge points, the connector cable and plug are already attached to the charge points. Be aware that the Cobbs Farm charge points are only accessible during the farm shop / café hours (https://www.cobbsfarmshops.co.uk/cobbs-hungerford). For the cheapest charging at Cobbs Farm having an Octopus Electroverse account is recommended to get an 8% discount.
