MATTERS ARISING

- 1 **SOLAR IDDEAS** Meeting, 18th March. This was also successfully conducted online, using ZOOM. 18/20 people on call. IDDEAS are unable to conduct SURVEYS at present, due to current restrictions. However, Helen reported that interest and response was good.
- 2 **TREE PROJECT** 19TH March. Frances reported the planting of over 400 free tree saplings from **Woodland Trust**, to create a woodland on Wilton Farm, whilst cold, was well done by approx. 25 volunteers from St Lawrence Church and HEAT. This is on private farm land so not thought to have public access.
- 3 **CAR SHOW** originally planned for the 20th June, will be postponed, hopefully to a date in Sept.. this year. **ACTION** - John will check dates with Town and Manor.
