



## CARBON-BUSTING PIONERS!

For the last 12 years M&F of Priory Road have been on a determined mission to cut the energy carbon emissions from their detached, 1930's, mains gas-heated home.

Starting in 2010 they began with solar hot water heating, quickly followed in 2011 by putting PV solar panels on their roof. Last year they had the house external cavity walls filled with heat insulation and more recently had the walls treated to reduce even further any remaining heat "leaks".

The solar water heating provides them with ample hot water from April to October with zero emissions.

Meanwhile, the clean solar electricity has reduced and, at times, eliminated their grid electricity consumption during

the last 11 years and should continue to do so for at least another 14.

It even helps to top-up their electric car battery – another part of their carbon-cutting drive!
